The main idea of 1 Chronicles 17:16-27:

God establishes a people after His own heart by speaking His will into their hearts.



The following questions can be used during a family worship time. Take time as a family this week to talk about the Story and what you are learning as you read. The hymns on the next pages are from our worship service. Sing them together as a family during your family worship time this week.

Discussion questions:

Have you ever had to face a bully or a big problem? What did you do? Did you ask anyone for help?

If you are in a time of waiting on the Lord right now, what can you do to remain faithful to God during this season? How can your family members pray for you and support you while you are in this waiting season?

How was David able to face a giant when so many others gave way to fear?

As a family:

In our personal deserts and seasons of waiting, we need to remember that God is with us. But we can also take comfort in knowing that God's people are walking with us too. Think about a family member or friend who is in the midst of a hard time. Pray for them together as a family. Ask God to use you as a conduit of His love, a visible reminder that He is with them, caring for them. And ask them how you might come alongside to offer care and support.
