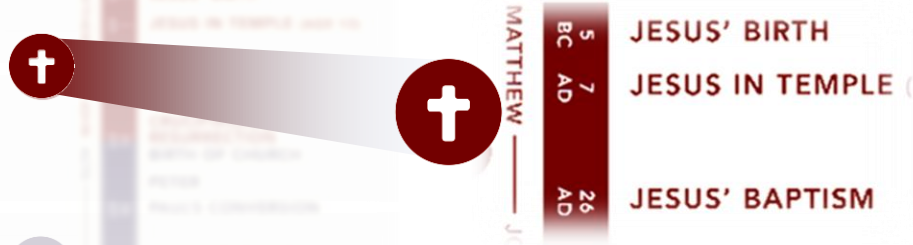
Discussion questions:
