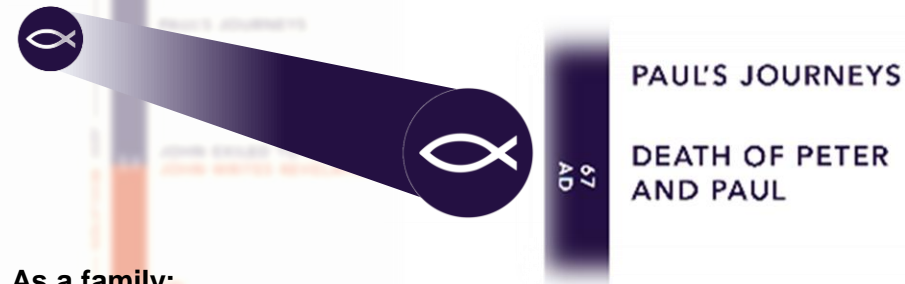
Discussion questions:

Tell about one big contrast people would see if they could watch a twenty-four-hour video surveillance tape of your life before you trusted Jesus as Savior compared to who you are today.
